

SCHOOL UNIFORM

A list of uniform is provided below; it is essential that all items of uniform are named as most items look the same.

The school instils a sense of pride in the children wearing their uniform correctly as this demonstrates that they are ready to engage in learning, we ask that parents support the school in ensuring that children understand that shirts should be tucked in, top buttons to be kept done up and ties in place.

RECEPTION TO YEAR 6 UNIFORM

items which are required and are branded are in bold

White school shirt or blouse

Bentley Heath striped school tie (elasticated for Reception and KS1)

Bentley Heath red V-neck jumper or cardigan- with school logo

Grey shorts, trousers, skirt or pinafore

Grey socks or tights

Black shoes (not trainers)

Red hair accessories and head bands, if worn

During the summer (from Easter until October half term) pupils may choose to wear a white polo shirt instead of their shirt and tie, or a red and white checked summer dress.

PE KIT AND GAMES KIT

Our P.E Kit is as follows and is worn to school on PE days

Black shorts or tracksuit / jogging bottoms

White sports t-shirt with red sleeves (available from Palmers only) OR a plain white t-shirt

White or black trainers

Red PE hoody with school logo (optional) OR plain black or dark grey sweatshirt or hooded jumper

NURSERY UNIFORM

We feel it is important that our youngest children feel part of our school. Our Nursery uniform reflects this.

Bentley Heath sweatshirt or PE hoodie – with school logo

White or Red polo shirt

Black or grey tracksuit bottoms

Grey socks

Black shoes

HAIR STYLING, JEWELLERY, WATCHES AND PHONES

- Shoulder length hair or longer must be tied back.
- Hair bands and 'bobbles' should be school colours, eg. red, white, red/white check or black. Large claw style clips are not allowed.
- Extreme hairstyles, colour, gel, wax or mousse are not permitted.
- Infant children may not wear jewellery or watches.
- Junior children may not wear jewellery but may wear a watch that does not 'beep' and is not a Smart Watch.
- For health and safety reasons, earrings for pierced ears are not allowed and must be removed before coming to school. Please do not allow your child to have their ears pierced during term time. Summer holidays are an ideal time for this.
- Children are not permitted to bring Smartphones or Smart Watches to school, if circumstances are exceptional, please contact the Headteacher. If a child brings a basic phone this must be handed in to be locked in the office at the start of the day.
- Fitness Trackers are only permitted if they have no camera capability, *if a child is distracted by their item staff can ask that a child remove it and all such items must be removed for PE.*

FOOTWEAR

- No ankle boots, boots, open-toed sandals or sling backs are permitted
